

## **Child Safe Standards**

**Young Adventurers is committed to creating and maintaining a child safe organisation where children and young people are safe and feel safe.**

Child Safety is embedded in everyday thinking and practice thus protecting children and young people from child abuse, providing cultural safety for all children including Aboriginal children and young people, children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, children with disabilities, children living in Out Of Home Care, LGBTQIA+ children and families, and children who are vulnerable.

Any type of abuse, discrimination, racism or bias within the organisation is identified, confronted and not tolerated.

The Child Safe Standards provide 11 Standards focusing on educator practice, management responsibilities and recruitment, screening and training of staff to ensure that all children and young people are protected from abuse.
